

TITLE OF THE ACTIVITY	Hotels and Hostels: Vocabulary
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50-WORD SUMMARY	This Power Point links students to two vocabulary lists on Quizlet, where they can practice high-frequency words that they would need to be able to scan Russian hostel sites for important information.

RUSSIAN STANDARDS	Elementary
SKILLS	Students are developing reading skills. They will be developing their ability to function in Russia by finding a place to stay. Much of this vocabulary can also be applied to hotel and apartment searches.
MODE	This activity can be for distance learning, independent learning, or for extra practice in preparation for an appropriate unit.
MATERIALS	The activity uses a PowerPoint that includes links to two Quizlet vocabulary lists.
INSTRUCTIONS FOR TEACHERS	Exercises attached to this PowerPoint are meant to give students a quick overview of critical vocabulary they will find on a Russian hostel site. Teachers can require that students set up a test with a specific number of items and specific kinds of items. For instance, the instructor can require that the students set the test to 15 items that are all short-answer or multiple-choice, or a mixture of any of the item types. Students can email screen shots of their test grades on Quizlet to their teachers, and teachers may set up a class account to view scores on the site. It is possible to reconfigure the test for true/false, fill-in, or multiple-choice questions. After using this PowerPoint, students can feel more confident as they review hostel sites.
INSTRUCTIONS FOR LEARNERS	Follow the directions in the PowerPoint to access the vocabulary lists in the Quizlet program. You do not need to set up an account unless you wish to keep track of your scores, or unless your instructor has a class group set up for you. You may print out the vocabulary on flash cards, play games, hear the items read to you, and take practice tests. Your instructor may ask you to set a specific type of quiz item for the test and/or a specific number of questions in the test.
